Introduction

For anyone with absolutely no experience of drawing and painting this is the course for you. During the course you will learn how to use a range of drawing materials which will include pencils, charcoal and coloured pencils. You will also be introduced to watercolour paints the use of colour and some basic painting techniques. If you have never done any drawing or painting since school or have always been one of those people who can't draw a straight line then this is the course for you.

What are the course entry requirements?

None just a willingness to experiment and enjoy learning how to draw and paint.

What will the course involve?

Learning techniques for a variety of drawing media by producing practise exercises within a wide variety of topics

How will I be learning?

Following demonstrations. Handouts. Group exercises.

What equipment will I need?

A4 cartridge paper sketch pad or similar.

2B & 6B Drawing Pencils, Rubber

Bring any other materials you may already have but **do not** purchase anything else until you have spoken to the tutor. Expect to spend about £15 after advice from the tutor.

How will I know if I am making progress?

Your tutor will monitor your progress by carrying out an assessment at the start of the course and giving individual help and advice during each session. There will also be group discussion, question and answer and peer assessment as an ongoing part of the course.

What course work will I be expected to complete?

Home work will be set although it is not compulsory to do it

What can I expect to learn from this course?

Basic techniques for several mediums.
How to draw basic shapes and simple pictures using measuring, negative spaces and other methods.
