Floristry NCFE Level 2

Introduction

The course will enable learners to gain the skills and knowledge appropriate to commercial floristry and is industry recognised. The qualification consists of 3 mandatory units which learners will work towards over the 3 terms. Learners need to have some previous experience of floristry.

***Please note that payment in September will have the additional cost of a registration fee, certification fee and Internal Verification fee.**

What are the course entry requirements?

To get the best from this course you should be able to:

- follow verbal and written instructions in English, including numerical information
- use a computer to search for information

How long is the course?

This is a 60 hour course of 2.5 hours a week over 3 terms.

What will the course involve?

The qualification consists of 3 mandatory units run over 3 terms.

- UNIT 1 Use materials and resources to develop floristry techniques
- UNIT 2 Develop and adapt floristry ideas creatively
- UNIT 3 Create, present and evaluate final floristry items

How will I be learning?

Learners will progress through practical experience and be given individual help and attention according to their level and need; there will be some group discussions and mutual feedback between learners; independent study and practise will be encouraged.

What equipment will I need?

Learners will need to provide their own flowers, foliage, sundries and equipment.
Camera to take photographs of their work to be included in the portfolio.

How will I know if I am making progress?

Evaluation of progress and achievement will be an ongoing process throughout the course. The tutor will ensure that time is spent with all learners during each session for individual discussion and feedback.

What course work will I be expected to complete?

What can I expect to learn from this course?

In order to achieve the qualification Learners will need to produce a portfolio of their work which will be used for assessment at the end of the course. A formal assessment project will be set for each term.

Will I need to cover anything in addition to the course fee?

Learners are expected to provide their own equipment and foliage. Tutor will be able to advise.
