Free Carers Awareness Training

Do you know which of your customers or staff are carers?

- There are 6 million carers in the UK
- 13 million can expect to become carers in the next decade
- Unpaid carers save the county £87 billion a year – this could have an impact on you and your organisation

This training aims to increase awareness and understanding of who a carer is and what support can be provided, both on an individual and organisational level. It will challenge your own feelings and ideas on what/who is a carer and will help you to gain an awareness of the everyday attitudes and challenges that face carers.

Training can be delivered in the workplace and will be tailored to meet organisational needs.

- Clearly identify who is a carer
- Describe the difference between paid and unpaid carers
- Identify and recognise issues and barriers faced by carers
- Discuss how to engage with carers of all ages
- Discuss levels of support for carers and the role of a carer centre
- Identify what you and your organisation can do to support carers and the benefits of doing this
- Share practices, personal experience and expertise that will have a positive impact on carers
